



Fuzz Bud Instructions

Get to know your new Fuzz Buds.

- Your package has a set of Fuzz Buds, a charging cable and these instructions. The cord connecting the 2 dice is permanently attached.
- Your Fuzz Buds were designed to hang from the mirror of your car letting you use your phone hands free while driving. They can also be used anywhere you want hands free calling or a set of nice speakers for listening to music, pod casts or whatever.
- Each pair of Fuzz Buds has a main die and a speaker only die. The main die has the Watsons StreetWorks name on the bottom. You can also feel buttons beneath the surface of the #5 side. The #3 side has a charging port at the top.
- You control your Fuzz Buds from the #5 surface of the main die.
 - To turn your Fuzz Buds on or off press the button behind the lower right dot. We have placed a label with the on/off symbol over that dot. The label is removable so you can take it off once you are accustomed to its location. When the unit is on you should see a glow in that area. (you may not be able to see this in bright sunlight.)
 - The microphone is behind the dot at the top left. For best results you will want this pointed in your general direction when speaking.
 - The button behind the center dot is for connecting or disconnecting a call. It will pause music if you're in play mode on the device you have paired with.
 - Press and hold the top right button to increase the volume. A short press will skip to the next track on your player.
 - Press and hold the Bottom left button to decrease the volume. A short press will skip to the previous track on your player. Note that you will have a much wider range of volume control by using the settings on the paired device.

Pairing your Fuzz Buds to your Bluetooth device

- Most modern phones will easily pair to your Fuzz Buds.
- In the Bluetooth settings screen of your phone or music device first be sure you are not paired to any other nearby devices.
- Turn on the Fuzz Buds.
- On your phone scan for devices to pair with. The Fuzz Buds are identified as "LANNI". Select that device and once it says connected you are all set.
- Note that certain older devices may need the Fuzz Buds to send out a pairing signal. This can be done by pressing the center button on your Fuzz Buds.

Charging your Fuzz Buds

- Your Fuzz Buds have a large capacity battery that will provide many hours of music and voice communication. A low battery will drop the pairing to Bluetooth device. When you need to charge the battery follow these simple steps.
- Plug the charging cable into the charging port at the top center of the #3 side of the main die.
- Plug the other end into and USB charging device in your car, your laptop, a wall charger or any other device with a USB port.
- A small red LED light will illuminate next to the charging port while the device is charging.
- The light will turn green when the battery is fully charged. (Because of the foam padding and the cloth cover these lights may be hard to see.)
- You may continue to use the Fuzz Buds while they are charging.
